MOTION FOR EX PARTE HEARING

Now comes the juvenile in the above-captioned case and respectfully moves that this Honorable Court hear his Motion for Funds ex parte.

As grounds for said motion the juvenile states that the Commonwealth has “no proper role” on this issue. Commonwealth v. Dotson, 402 Mass 185, 187 (1988) (prosecutors serve neither the judicial process nor the interests of justice by impeding the indigent defendant’s efforts to obtain funds pursuant to G.L. c. 261 §27C). If the defendant were not indigent he would retain the services of an expert without the Commonwealth’s knowledge. The Commonwealth should not be able to interfere with the defendant’s right to prepare his case.
